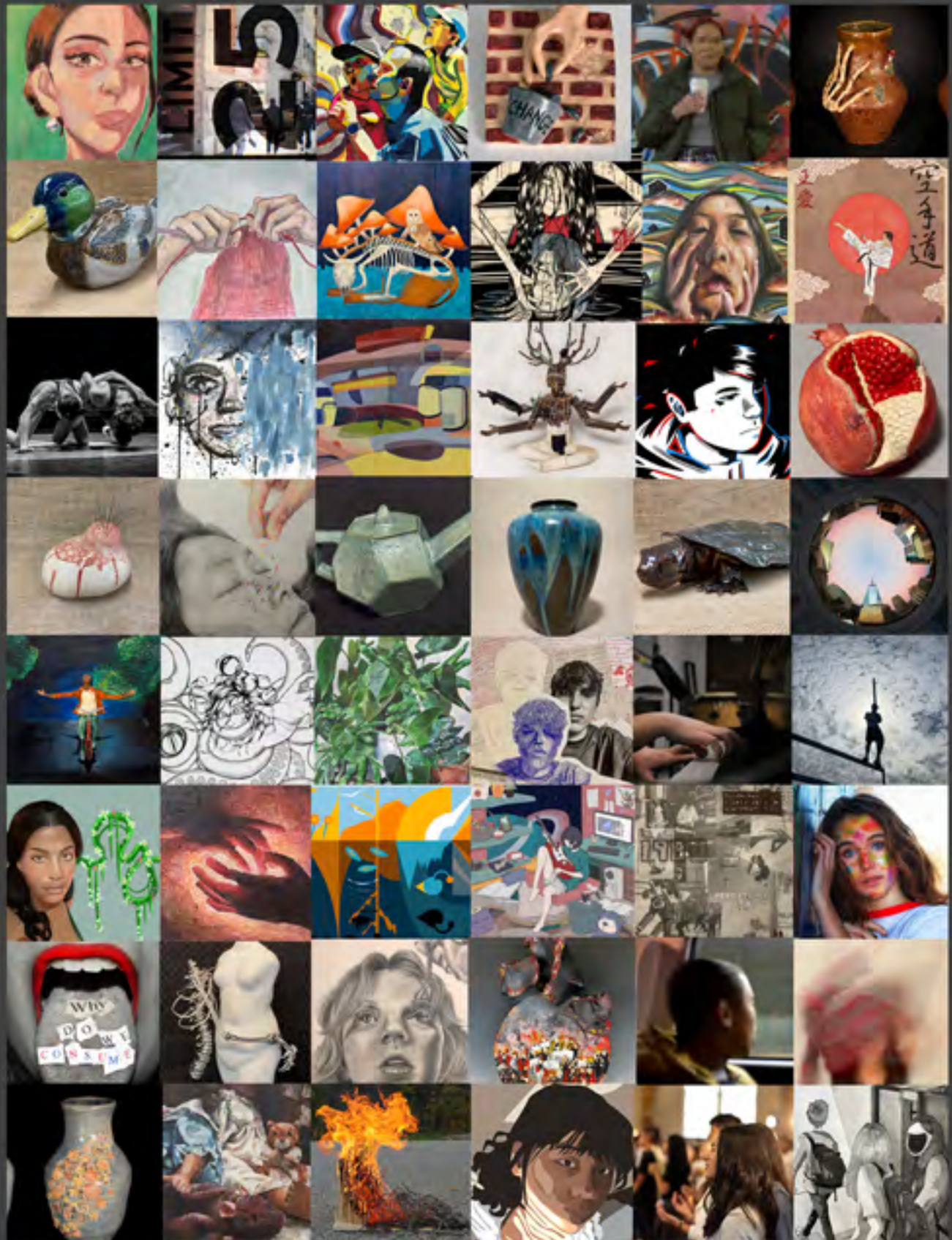


FRESH PERSPECTIVES

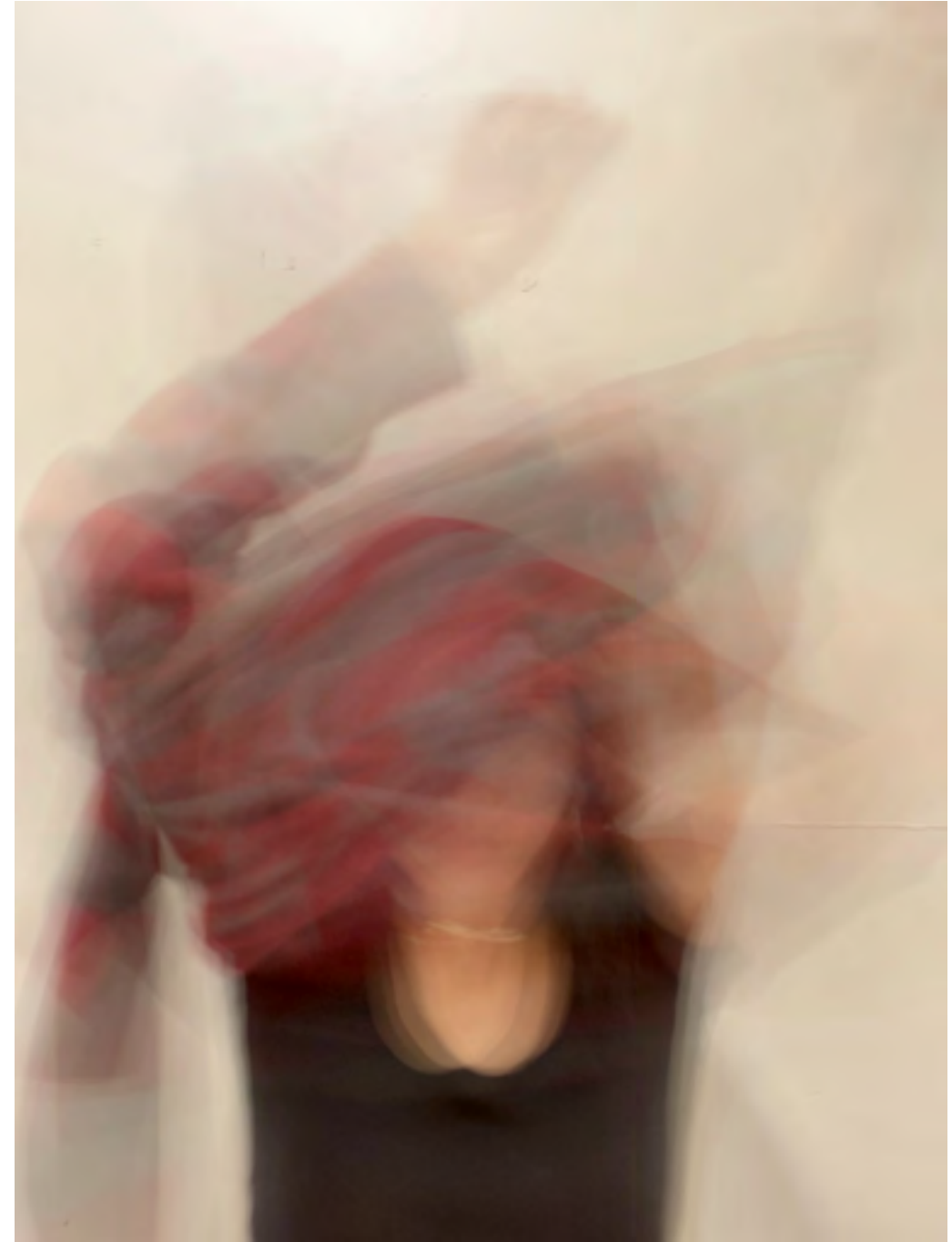

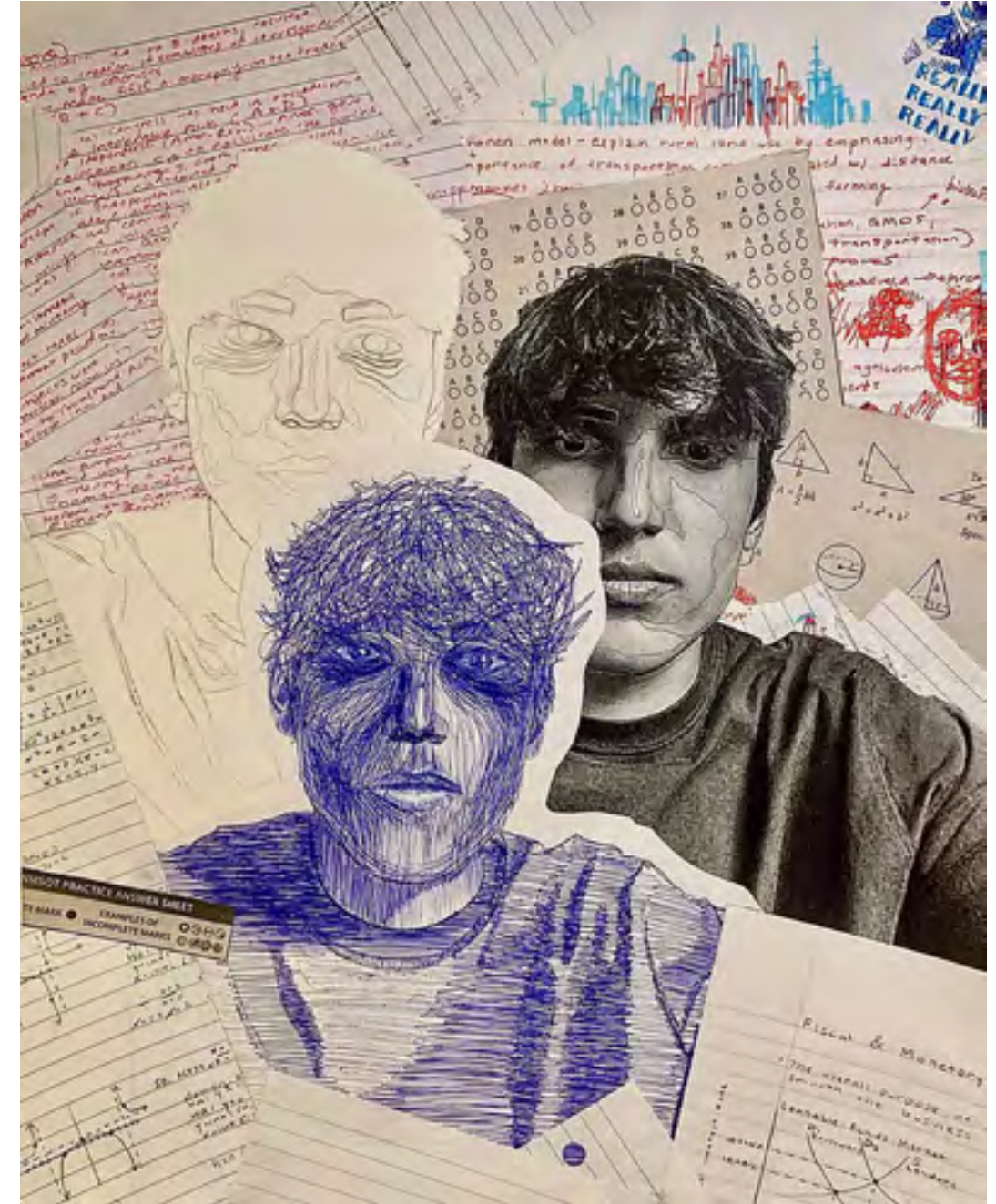

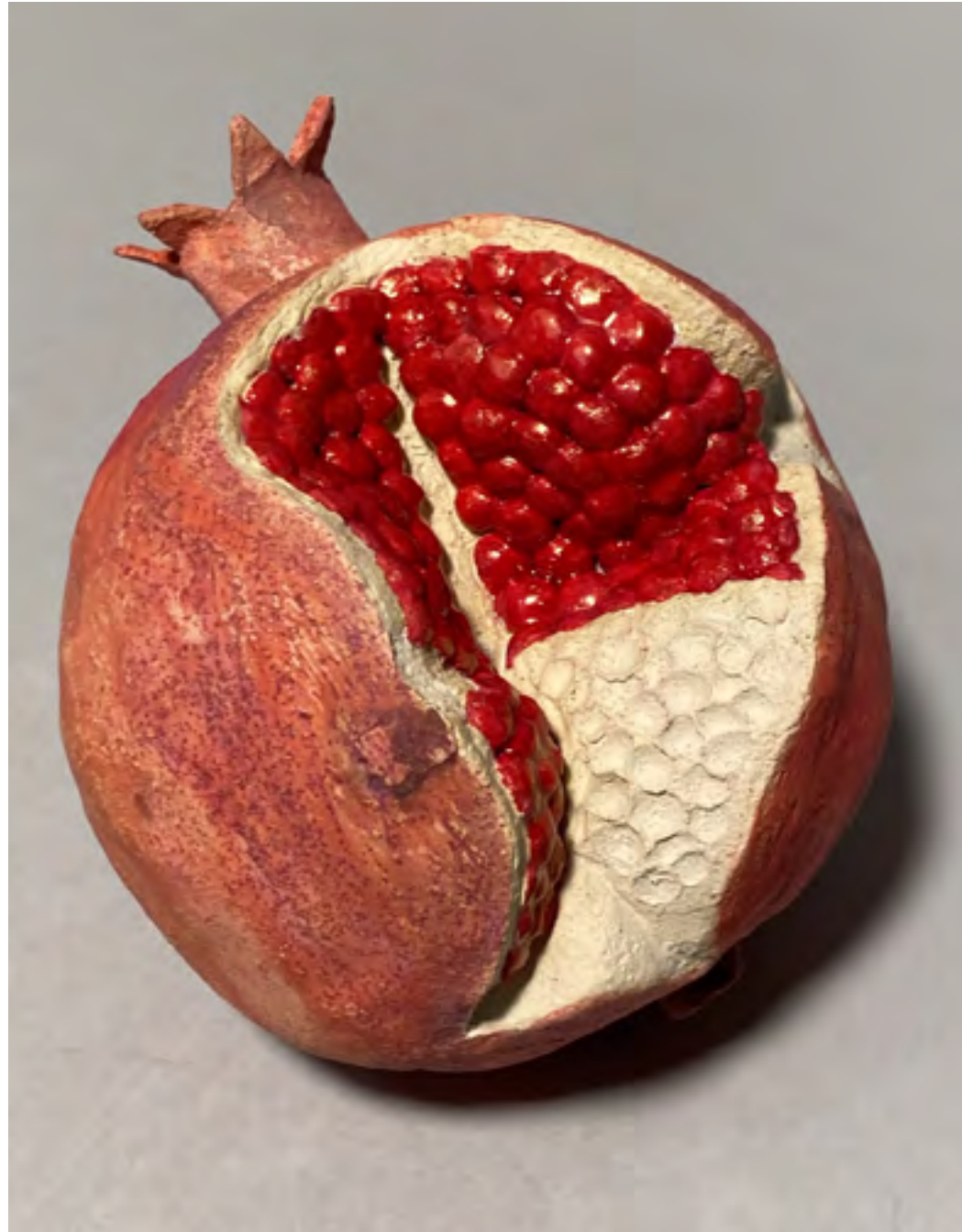

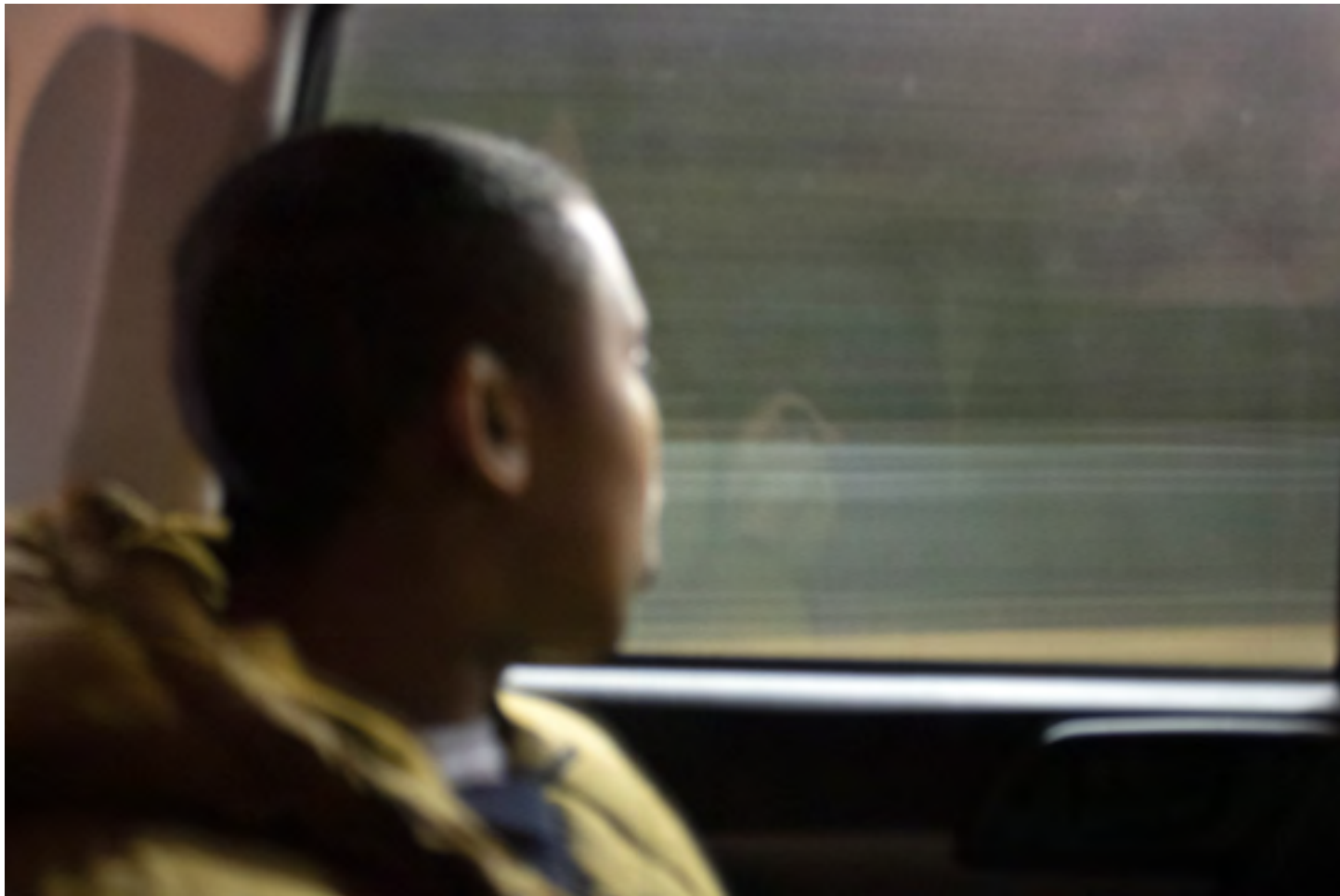

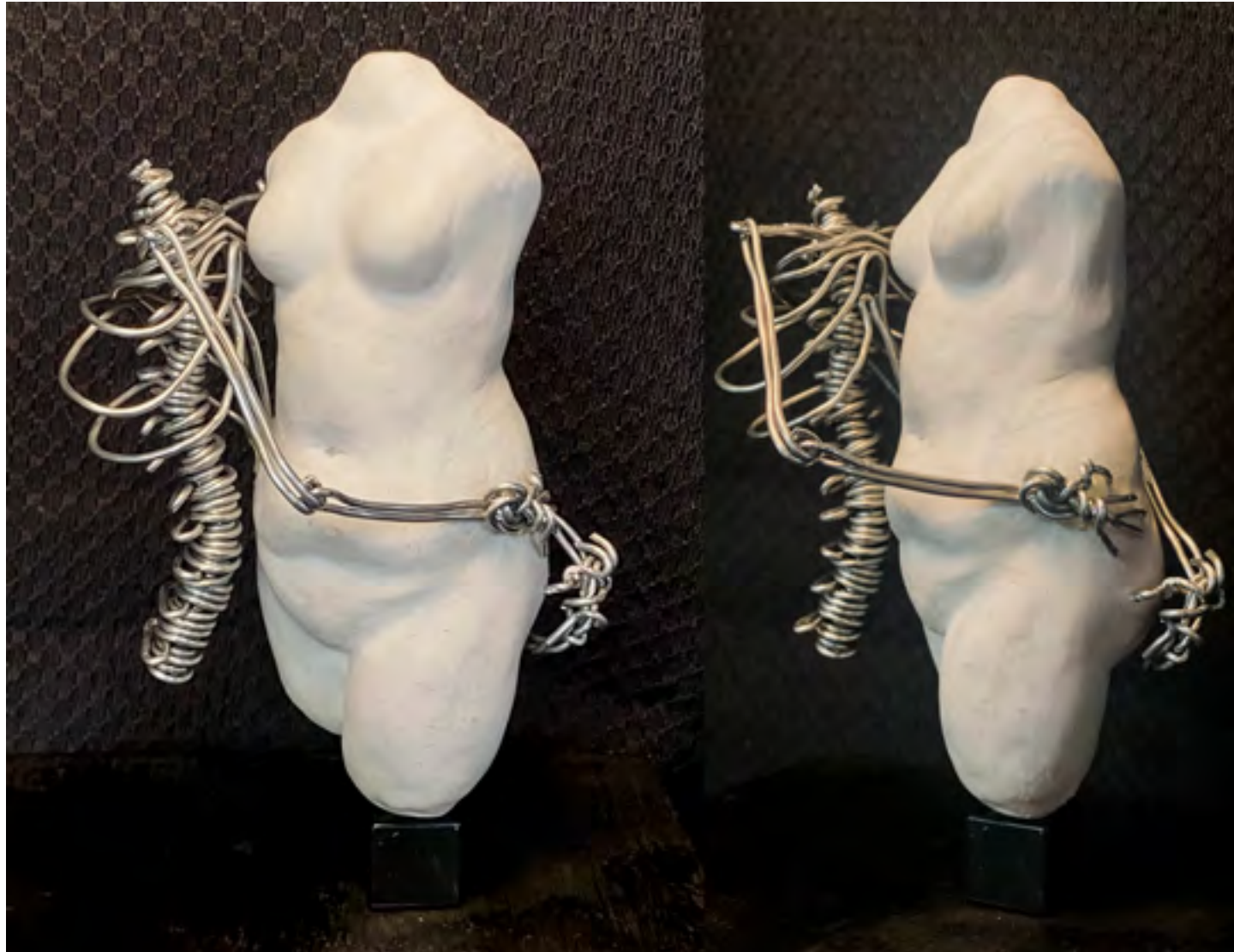
